## How to Cover Residential Addiction Treatment Costs With Insurance

## CAN I USE INSURANCE TO PAY FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT?

So, now that you've made the decision to look for a residential addiction treatment program, how does insurance work? Insurance can help you pay for your residential addiction program, but how much it covers depends on whether you or your loved one's insurance carrier is in-network or out-of-network You may even be paying outof-pocket. What do those terms mean and how can they help you pay for residential addiction treatment? Read on to find out:

### **IN-NETWORK**

In-network means that you or your loved one's health insurance provider is contracted with the residential treatment program. If a treatment facility is in-network, the total cost may be lower and your insurance carrier may cover a larger percentage of expenses for addiction treatment. Most of the time, your deductible is significantly less for in-network services than for out-ofnetwork services. If your health insurance plan has a deductible that hasn't been met, you would have to pay for the remainder of your deductible before your insurance company would cover any expenses.

#### **OUT-OF-NETWORK**

If an addiction treatment facility is out-of-network, it means that the program is not contracted with your insurance carrier. Out-of-network services hold a higher deductible rate, which you'd have to meet before your insurance company begins to cover your addiction treatment expenses.

If you have met your deductible, your insurance will begin paying for your residential stay at an addiction treatment facility, but the amount of coverage may be less than if you were innetwork. Still, don't choose a treatment center simply based on the fact that you're in-network; choose the right facility for yourself or your loved one. Addiction treatment centers are not all the same, and programming and quality can vary a lot.
